- All crop entries are to be the product of 2011
- The Committee/Society will determine the division of north and south sides of the township
- Exhibitors must include Field Division entries as well as Hall Exhibits on their entry form to qualify for prizes

Rules for Most Points and Specials in Crop Competition:

- Final Standing in Crop Competitions will be determined on the following basis:

HARD RED FALL WHEAT, SOFT WHITE FALL WHEAT,  
SOFT RED FALL WHEAT, SPRING WHEAT,  
SPRING BARLEY, MIXED GRAIN, OATS -  
100 points for field and 50 points for grain exhibit at Fair

ENSILAGE CORN -  
100 points for field and 50 points for corn sheaf

GRAIN CORN -  
100 points for field and 50 points for 15 cobs

NEW SEEDED HAY -  
100 points for field and 50 points for hall exhibit from bale of new seeded hay

ESTABLISHED HAY -  
100 points for field and 50 points for hall exhibit from bale of established hay

SOYBEANS -  
100 points for field and 50 points for exhibit of 10 stalks of beans

## Display Table of Organic Crops

### RULES:

1. Educational, not competitive.
2. Displays need to be clearly marked on entry tag.
3. Entry exhibitor number required.

### FIELD DIVISION COMPETITION

#### Rules:

- To qualify for field division prize money, an exhibit of the same crop must be shown at the Fair.
- **Exhibitors must include Field Division entries on their entry form using the numbers 1 - 12 for crops judged in the exhibitor's field**

### CROP COMPETITION - HALL EXHIBITS

#### CORN EXHIBITS

13. Corn Sheaf – 10 stalks with cobs attached  
Prizes: \$10; \$8; \$6; and \$4 for each additional entry
14. Grain Corn – 15 Cobs  
Prizes: \$14; \$12; \$10; \$8; \$6; and \$5 for each additional entry
15. Ensilage corn – 6 cobs  
Prizes: \$8; \$7; \$6; \$5; \$4; and \$3 for each additional entry

#### CORN SPECIALS

#### Rules for Corn Specials:

- Variety of corn to be clearly marked on the exhibit tag of each entry to qualify
  - Exhibitors must be entered in field and hall competition to qualify.

### **HAY EXHIBITS**

Rules for Hay Competition:

- Each exhibit is to be a 12 inch thick section or flake of a bale
- Exhibit must be mowed dry hay

22. New Seeded – 1st cut hay
23. Established – 2nd year or longer, 1st cut hay
24. Second Cut Hay

Prizes in section 22 - 24: \$7, \$6, \$5, \$4, \$3 and \$2 for each additional entry.

Courtney Grain and Seed donate \$60.00 towards the hay prize money.

### **HAY SPECIALS**

Rules for Hay Specials:

- To qualify for hay specials, exhibitors must exhibit in both field and hall competitions.

### **GRAIN EXHIBITS**

Rules for Grain Competition:

- Grain must be cleaned for exhibition
- Must be exhibited in plastic bags provided by Society
- Variety of grain to be clearly marked on entry tag

Prizes in section 29 – 38: \$14, \$12, \$10, \$8, \$6 and \$5 for each additional entry

**SHEAVES**

Rules for Sheaf Competition:

- Sheaves to measure approximately 5 to 7 inches in diameter at the centre binder or ribbon
- Grain may or may not be grown by exhibitor

Prizes in section 39 – 41: \$16, \$14, \$12, \$10, and \$8 for each additional entry

**JUNIOR SHEAF COMPETITION**

42. Rules for Junior Sheaf Competition:

- Sheaf of wheat or oats or barley may be shown in this section
- Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or under
- Sheaves to measure approximately 5 to 7 inches in diameter at the centre binder or ribbon
- Grain may or may not be grown by exhibitor

Prizes in section 42: \$16, \$14, \$12, \$10, and \$8 for each additional entry
