SECTION 2 - GROUP DISPLAY

Exhibitors must be an organized group, church, Women's Institute etc., not individuals.

All items to be homemade, unless otherwise specified.

All entries to be judged on appearance and quality of work.

Exhibitors must complete an entry form with name and complete mailing address of a contact person.

1. A scarecrow not to exceed 13".
2. A loaf of raisin bread, taste to count. 
3. A plate of 5 fall decorated cupcakes, appearance to count.
4. A door swag to include Indian corn.
5. A collection of 6 different nature items, labeled and displayed (e.g. in an egg carton).
6. Fresh flowers with hues of autumn not to exceed 13".
7. Something useful made from something discarded.
8. A handmade tote bag.
9. A quilt block approximately 12" x 12".
10. Creativity, appearance, and presentation.

Theme title is to be displayed but each item does not need to be labeled.
