1. **Deadline** for entries: **September 1, 2011**. Completed entry forms, one entry per line, to be sent to Ripley Agricultural Society, Box 151, Ripley, Ontario N0G 2R0. Please note entries will only be registered when received by the secretary.
2. All exhibits are to be placed and ready for judging by 9:30 a.m. Saturday, September 24, 2011.
3. Past Exhibitors have first opportunity to fill available spaces - only 300 birds accepted in show.
4. Entry fee of \$.50 per bird **MUST** accompany entry form and be received by the secretary by deadline. Junior Exhibitors are excluded from this rule.
5. New exhibitors must include the \$5.00 membership fee with entry form and entry fees. Include full name, address, postal code and telephone number.
6. Upon receipt of membership fee (required for new members only) and entry fees (\$.50 per bird) by the deadline, the Society will forward one fair admission pass for each membership for Saturday, September 24th.
7. In filling out entry forms use: A for Cock; B for Hen; C for Cockerel; and D for Pullet along with the class and section number on entry form.
8. Exhibitors are limited to one bird per section. Waterfowl included in this rule.
9. If more than 4 entries of same breed are in an A.O.V. class, directors have privilege to split class.
10. The class will be shown in wire cages. Appropriate size cages for ducks and geese are to be supplied by Exhibitors.
11. Should any questions arise not provided for in the rules and regulations, the decision of the Board of Directors and Committees shall be final. Rule 36 - General Rules.
