POTTED PLANTS

Clean foliage with dead blooms removed. MUST BE HOME INDOOR GROWN UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED or will be disqualified. NEW EXHIBITORS PLEASE MARK TAGS AS FIRST YEAR.

If more than 10 entries in a class, 2 extra prizes of \$1.00 will be awarded. If more than 18 entries, the class will be split.**

1. African Violet, single crown, light colour
2. African Violet, single crown, dark colour
3. Plant with a religious name - named
4. Collection of Cacti and /or succulents, grown in one container
5. Baby Tears
6. Coleus, potted at least one month
7. Hibiscus in bloom
8. Fern, any kind, named if possible
9. Attractive Ivy, trained to climb, any type, supports allowed
10. Orchid in bloom
11. Aloe Vera plant
12. Decorative Plant, potted, one variety only, grown for foliage not mentioned above
13. Any other house plant, one variety only, in bloom, not mentioned above
14. Outdoor hanging planter, mixed, hanger not to be judged
15. Outdoor hanging planter, single variety, hanger not to be judged
16. Begonia(s) tuberous, in bloom, potted at least one month
17. Geranium(s) in bloom, potted at least one month
18. Patio (outdoor) planter, one variety of plant
19. Patio (outdoor) planter, two or more varieties of plants
20. Rare house plant, named

CUT FLOWERS

PLEASE USE A CONTAINER SUITABLY WEIGHTED TO PREVENT TIPPING (i.e. sand or stone). Include its own foliage when possible.

BLOOM - an individual flower, one to a stem, do not leave buds showing

STEM - may carry one or more flowers and buds

SPIKE - a thick, upright stem carrying several flowers.

SPRAY - a portion of the plant with a number of flowers on one stem

COLLECTION - a minimum of 3 different varieties

DISPLAY - may be one or more varieties

22. Cosmos, 7 stems
23. Snapdragons, best collection
24. Canna Lily, 1 spike
25. Dahlia, 1 bloom, 4" - 6" with foliage
26. Dahlia, 1 bloom, over 6" with foliage
27. Dahlia, 3 of one variety with foliage
28. Dahlia, 1 bloom, no more than 2" in diameter
29. Gladiolus, 1 stem
30. Gladiolus, 2 stems, any colour
31. African Marigold, 5 blooms (2 1/2 " or more)
32. French Marigold, 5 blooms (less than approx. 2 ")
33. Best display of Mums, variety and colour to count
34. Best display of Mums, one colour only
35. Pansies, 5 stems in suitable container
36. Petunias, best display, any type
37. A collection of native/roadside plants and/or flowers
38. Best display of Fall flowers, at least three different types
39. Rose, 1 hybrid Tea

49. "Flower Girls Basket"-a bridal bouquet using flowers and/or wild flowers, accessories allowed.
50. "Coffee Break"- an arrangement in a coffee mug.
51. "Indian Summer"- a fresh centrepiece in a pumpkin using fall colours. (pumpkins not to exceed 4" in any direction)
52. "Autumn Hues"-a front porch display in fall colours using fall leaves, flowers, twigs, etc.
53. "A little goes a long Way"-a fresh arrangement not to exceed 4" in any direction.
54. "Green with Envy"-arrangement using only foliage in shades of green.
55. "Lavender and Lace"- an arrangement using shades of purple and white flowers in a sugar bowl.
56. "Rise and Shine"-an arrangement in an egg cup.
57. "Reflections"- a flower arrangement displayed with mirror(s) or reflective material i.e CD.
58. "Floating Garden"- any flower with own foliage, not necessarily attached, floating on water, not roses. 
59. "Morning Dew"- 1 rose bloom with own foliage, not necessarily attached, floating on water.

60. "A Walk in the Pines"- an arrangement in a 10"or 12" pot suitable for an insert in an urn, using evergreens, twigs, weeds, accessories allowed.
61. "Horn of Plenty"- fresh flowers in a cornucopia in autumn shades.
62. "Sweeter than Wine"-an arrangement in a wine glass in shades of purple.
63. "September Splendor"- An arrangement with a harvest theme.
64. "We Give Thanks"-a dining room table arrangement in fall shades. Not to exceed 8" in height.
