Note: Nuts and nut by-products may be used in baking. Entries to be homemade by exhibitor. Please attach entry tags on OUTSIDE of bag. Display in a clear plastic bag on an UNBREAKABLE PLATE. Baked items to be made at least 12 hours prior to judging day. If more than 10 entries in a class, 2 extra prizes of \$1.00 will be awarded. If more than 18 entries, the class will be split.

1. **60% Whole Wheat Bread Special** - entire loaf. NO BREAD MACHINE. NOTE: Winner will also be asked to bake another loaf for the District Annual Meeting and the possibility of one more for the Annual Convention in February in Toronto.

NOTE: The minimum pan sizes for breads and loaves is 8" x 4" x 2 1/2" or 20cm x 10 cm x 7 cm.

The maximum pan size is 9" x 5" x 3" or 23 cm x 13 cm x 7.5 cm. Sizes are approximate.

Filling:

- 4 large eggs
- 1/3 cup all purpose flour
- 1/2cup lemon juice
- 1 3/4 cup sugar
- 1/2 tsp. baking powder

Base: sift flour, sugar, and salt together.

Cream margarine/butter and add base mixture until it blends into a pliable dough.

Pat evenly into bottom of a 9 x 13" pan

Bake at 350 for 11 minute

Filling: beat ingredients until smooth. Mix well

Pour over Hot base. Return to oven and bake at 350 for 28 min. Cool. Can be dusted with icing sugar if desired.

1 1/2 cups all purpose flour

1 cup whole wheat flour

1 cup uncooked quick or old fashioned oats

2 tsp. baking soda

1 1/2 tsp. salt

2 eggs

1 1/2 cups buttermilk

1/2 cup Crown Lily white or Golden Corn Syrup

1/2 cup packed brown sugar

1/4 cup Mazola Corn oil

1 cup raisins

Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease and flour 2 (9"x5"x3") loaf pans. Combine flours, oats, baking soda, salt. Combine eggs, buttermilk, syrup, sugar and corn oil until blended, stir into flour mixture until moistened. Stir in raisins. Put in pans. Bake 45-50 minutes approx. Cool in pans 10 minutes.
