Please mark age of child in top right hand corner of exhibitor tags.

1. Open to boys and girls 11 years and under and 12 - 18 years old as of DEC. 31, 2011. **Please read each category regarding age, as posters and specials use different age requirements. Please call a committee member if you have any questions.**
2. No entry fee, but exhibitors must obtain an exhibitor number from Ripley Agricultural Society at ripleyfair@hurontel.on.ca
3. Junior exhibitor numbers-800 and 900 series cannot be used to exhibit in adult section Juniors may exhibit in adult section by paying \$5.00 and obtaining an adult series number from secretary.
4. First year exhibitors will be given a 900 series number and subsequent years will receive an 800 series number.
5. If more than 10 entries in a class, 2 additional prizes will be added of \$1.25, \$1.00.
6. If more than 20 entries in a class, 2 firsts, 2 seconds, 2 thirds and 2 fourths will be awarded.
7. All cooking items must be displayed on a 6" UNBREAKABLE plate in a Ziploc plastic bag.
8. EXHIBITS MUST BE DISPLAYED UNTIL 4:30 P.M SATURDAY OF THE FAIR. Please remember to pick up exhibits at this time; the Committee or Ripley Agricultural Society or Arena Staff will not be responsible for articles left behind.

2. RIPLEY SOCIETY SPECIAL - Autumn Harvest Cookies

Exhibit 3 cookies on UNBREAKABLE 6" plate in a Ziploc bag, using the following recipe:

1 cup softened butter	1/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup brown sugar	1 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 cup white sugar	1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
2 eggs	2 1/2 cup rolled oats
1/2 teaspoon vanilla	1/2 cup chopped walnuts
1 1/2 cup all purpose flour	1 cup dried cranberries

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Cream together butter and sugars until smooth. Beat in eggs and vanilla. In a separate bowl combine the flour, salt, baking powder and pumpkin pie spice; stir flour mixture into sugar mixture. Add the rolled oats, walnuts and cranberries and mix thoroughly. Drop rounded spoonfuls onto the prepared cookie sheet.

Bake in preheated oven for 8 -10 minutes until the edges are golden. Allow the cookies to cool for 1 minute before removing to wire rack to cool completely.
